Geography:

Our lessons this half term will be focusing on North America and the contrasts to the UK. In this topic we will recap our understanding of technical language and our understanding of different time zones. We will be using books to explore physical and human features of both North America and parts of the UK. We will then be using a range of resources to explore the adventures that we could have in North America.

Maths

Angles on a straight line, about a point and in a quadrilateral.

Coordinates: to plot and find missing coordinates in all four quadrants.

Recapping our knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages.

Position and direction: translations, lines of symmetry and reflections.

Statistics

Art, Design Technology and Science

This half term we will be exploring the use of photography a little more, creating our own photomontages and understanding the use of digit techniques.

In Science we will be focusing on the topic 'Animals Including Humans' – a separate letter has been sent home regarding this topic and its links to RSE.

Computing

This half term, the children will be exploring the uses of websites, their structures and the legal requirements around copyright. They will discuss the use of images to support understanding and how it is important to preview a page.

Across all areas of the curriculum, we will be using the internet for research in order to develop digital literacy skills.

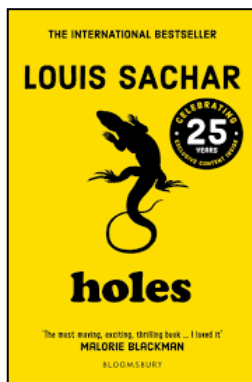
Reading

English

In this term's English lessons, we will be learning about David Attenborough and creating a short biography in the style of the Rebel Girl books. To support our learning we will be story mapping his life and recapping our understanding of parenthesis and semi colons and colons.

We will then be focusing on the novel 'Holes' set in a desert in North America. The class will be using their understanding from the text and the film to write a holiday advert and then a diary entry. Holes will continue to be our class shared read for this half term.
